Making the best investment

Not only is education a basic human right, but it also supports the development of all of society. Educated girls impact on the family, their communities and society at large. Literate mothers can make better decisions about their family's health and and it is a fact that national economies thrive when women are contributing their skills to employment.

Background

Education For All (EFA) was founded in 2007 to respond to the high levels of illiteracy (estimated at 80%) amongst girls in the most deprived and remote areas of the High Atlas Mountains in Morocco. Instead of going to school, girls were staying home, doing domestic chores, marrying young and remaining in the cycle of poverty with limited choices in life.

The 3 main obstacles for girls in rural Morocco

- Their villages are too far away from the few secondary schools
- Their families are too poor to afford the government lodgings and travel costs
- There is low awareness and value of educating girls

Solution



Ten years ago, a group of committed individuals living in Morocco (now the EFA Trustees) wanted to find a solution. In 2007 they raised money to build the first boarding house near one of the main secondary schools in Asni.


We now have **5 houses** running for over 180 girls. The EFA houses are a "home away from home". Safe, comfortable and well-equipped each house provides:

- **3 nutritious meals a day,**
- **a house-mother to support them,**
- **spaces to study and play,**
- **access to books and computers**

The houses are staffed by local women which helps to create an environment where their culture is respected and trust is built within the local community. We also run an **international volunteer programme** to support the girls in languages and also to broaden their horizons.

EFA in the Media

Impact

The **short-term impact** of EFA's work is that many girls now have the opportunity to go to school who otherwise would be at home, are thriving academically and becoming important role models in the region. **Your support** will enable girls to reach their potential, both academically and also by creating an empowered social network of other girls and women who are determined to realise their goals in life. We now have **31 girls at University** and more studying vocational diplomas- making them future lawyers, scientists, teachers and chefs in Morocco!



The **longer-term impact** is that these young women will be able to access **professional jobs, become financially independent, contribute to the economy and have a voice in Moroccan society- all of which wasn't possible before.** This is also significant due to the fact that they represent a marginalised social group, both as Berbers and as women.

Results

- **Increased confidence and skills (IT, Languages)**
- **Academic achievements- above the national average, university enrolment**
- **Essential life- skills (basic hygiene and health care)**

Sponsoring a Girl

Sponsoring a girl is a wonderful way to have a personal relationship with our project, help us sustain our work and ensure that more and more opportunities for schooling are available to girls in the High Atlas region. When you adopt a girl, we provide you with:

- **A photo** name and background information about the girl
- **Updates** about the girl's progress (exam results, university enrolment, employment)
- **Visiting** the girl at her boarding house (if you are already in Morocco).



It costs £800/\$1000/1000 Euros to sponsor a girl at the EFA houses for a year, which covers:

- **3 meals a day**
- **A percentage of bills, staff salaries, food, internet etc.**
- **Transport home at weekends and holidays**
- **Access to materials, books and computers**
- **Other essential items (toiletries, clothes)**

You can sponsor a girl by:

1. **Making an annual donation of £800/\$1000/1000 Euros via:**

2. **Making a monthly donation of £65/85 Euros by Standing Order**

Value

Due to minimal administrative costs, we can guarantee **95% of your donation** goes directly to the running of the boarding houses and local staff (all women). We can also guarantee that you have changed a girl's life forever!


